

# OVERVIEW

This is the official web site for the Honda Odometer Class Action Settlement.

In November 2006, class actions were brought against Honda Canada Inc. (“Honda”) in Ontario, British Columbia and Quebec alleging that the odometers in certain Honda and Acura passenger vehicles overstate mileage. Although these Honda odometers were within the design tolerance standard of the Society of Automotive Engineers, Honda agreed to settle the class actions in the interest of customer satisfaction. It agreed to do so without any admission of liability.

The terms of the Settlement, the benefits that those included in the class action (the “Class”) may be eligible for, and a description of who is included in the Class are described in the Settlement Agreement and the Notice, both of which can be accessed from this site.

The Settlement required the approval of the Courts in Ontario, B.C. and Quebec before it could be implemented. Effective May 11, 2009, the Courts in these three jurisdictions had provided their approval. Thus, the **Effective Date of the Settlement** as defined and used in the Settlement Agreement is **May 11, 2009**.

The deadline for objecting to the Settlement was March 20, 2009 and is now passed.

The deadline for excluding oneself or “opting out” of the Settlement was May 18, 2009 and is now passed.

With the Settlement approved by the Courts, implementation of the Settlement is now underway. As explained in the Question and Answer document available on this web site, many of the Settlement benefits will be extended automatically and will not require any further action by those in the Class. Certain benefits, however, can only be accessed if you submit a claim and the required Claims Package is received by the Honda Claims Centre during the Claims Period.

**The Claims Period is open now and will remain open until November 14, 2009. In order to be considered, your Claims Package must be received by the Honda Claims Centre by the November 14, 2009 deadline.**
